Division 102: Small Grains

All sheaves must be approximately 4 inches in diameter just below heads when tightly bound.

Division 103: Forage Crops

All exhibits must be about one-eight standard bale taken from the middle of the bona fide field-baled hay. No loose hay or uncured hay will be accepted.

Alfalfa (less than 10% grass)

Alfalfa grass (20-80% grass)

Clover (less than 10% grass)

Orchard grass—first cutting (less than 10% legumes, less than 20% other species)

Timothy—first cutting (less than 10% legumes, less than 20% other species)

Aftermath grass (regrowth grass less than 10% legumes)

Mixed species hay—first cutting, more than 20% each of 3 or more species (grasses and/or legumes)
