### **Division 203: Canned Goods**

- *All canned goods are recommended to be canned using USDA recommendations*
- *Only recipes published by reputable sources such as the USDA, State Extension Services, Ball, or Kerr provide acceptable levels of protection against spoilage and foodborne illness.*
- *Entries must be in “Mason-type” pint or quart canning jars with two-piece lids and must be sealed.*
- *Jams, Jellies, and Preserves must be processed and cannot be sealed with paraffin.*
- *Bands may be left on jar or can be removed. Judges reserve the right to remove band to inspect headspace and appearance.*
- *Products must have been canned since July 1st, 2024.*
- *All products must be labeled with the product name, date prepared, method of pack (hot or raw), and method of processing (boiling water or pressure). A label will be provided at registration to collect this information.*
