Check-In Times Monday, July 7, 2025 4pm – 8pm for all entries.

Check-Out Time Sunday, July 13th from 1-4pm

Exhibits will not be accepted outside of normal check-in times.

Exhibits cannot be picked up before normal check-out times. Removal of exhibits prior to scheduled check-out time will result in forfeiture of premium awards

Ribbons and premiums will not be awarded simply because the article is the best of its kind exhibited. The judge(s) must consider it worthy of a ribbon and premium based upon its intrinsic merit or may refuse to award a ribbon and premium of any kind.

In any class where there is no competition, the judges will award a ribbon based upon the merits of the item and corresponding premium will be paid. If in a class no exhibits are worthy, neither ribbons nor prize money will be awarded. The decision of the judges is final.

Premiums will be paid according to the records turned in by the chairpersons and not by the ribbons presented.

Fair officials will take every precaution for the safekeeping of exhibits after their final arrival and arrangement in the building but will not be responsible for any damage or loss that may occur.

Exhibitor may enter one entry per class unless noted otherwise.

Fair officials may dispose of food, vegetable, and other exhibits that develop rot or similar conditions making them undesirable for display throughout the week.
